# Music and the Mind

James Hudziak (University of Vermont, USA)



Known internationally for his work in the psychiatric genetics and developmental neuroimaging of child and adolescent behavior, Dr. James Hudziak, MD, is the Director of the Vermont Center for Children, Youth, and Families at the University of Vermont Medical Center and the University of Vermont's (UVM) College of Medicine. He is Professor of Psychiatry, Medicine, and Pediatrics at UVM, having trained at the University of Minnesota Medical School and Washington University in St. Louis, Missouri. He has been identified as being a member of the top 1% of Doctors in the United States. Dr. Hudziak is the creator of a health promotion and illness prevention treatment program entitled "The Vermont Family Based Approach", which is the direct result of his 30+ years in genetics and neuroscience. Dr. Hudziak's approach is based on the simple fact that the best way to promote health in children and families is to help the family. In this lecture, Dr. Hudziak will discuss the ways in which music may contribute to child emotional-behavioral health.
